

Project Details

What projects are trying to address?

- Most of the CSO projects are trying to address 3 issues Governance, entitlement and, Community organization. They are also taking up area specific issues.
- OUT of 20 projects 2 (JSP, PYK) are using other strategy then SHG formation. 5 projects NBJK, JSP, SGVK, SSS and Badlao are not working on livelihood directly through IGA approach, 3 CSOs PYK, CV and LJK have not taken any other issue than their focus's and Prayas is not addressing issue of governance directly.
- For issues of governance projects are forming pressure groups, training women on *Panchayates* projects, Awareness generation on PRI, organisation of camps, seminars, meeting etc. For issues of entitlement generation of awareness on entitlement and interface between people and government officers.
- For livelihood most of the efforts are centered projects towards skill development by the way of training, a few projects are also providing them backward and forward linkages. One project is also addressing the issues of food security.
- Community mobilization and capacity building is component of the almost all projects. Efforts are in the direction to develop leadership and origination skill. Awareness on social issues is also addressed.
- Projects are also taking up area specific issues in advocacy mode like dalit rights, entitlement and government services, environment, food security and social issue, child rights and health services.

Strategy adopted by the projects:

The projects have adopted mainly 3 types of strategies to addressing the issues.

- **Organisation:** In most of the projects formation of self-help groups is done. Federation formation at cluster, block or district level is also done to enable community to act as pressure group. Apart from village level committees and youth clubs etc are also mobilized by some CSO projects.

- **Capacity building:** Perhaps most stress is given on the capacity building of the community this is strategy is used in variety of forms in the projects.
 - Capacity building activities
 - For organization skill building
 - For Income generation skill development
 - For enabling the community to response on social and development issues

- **Awareness generation:**
 - Awareness on individual issues discrimination
 - Awareness on Social issues
 - Exposure tours
 - Mass information dissemination
 - Multi-stakeholder dialog
